

Reset the SSO system user password

If the "system" user account password has been forgotten or is locked, you can reset it with the following commands.

Windows:

```
cd /d C:\Program Files\Ubisecure\ubilogin-ss0\ubilogin\ldap  
adam\import.cmd system-password.ldif
```

Linux:

```
cd /usr/local/ubisecure/ubilogin-ss0/ubilogin/ldap  
./openldap/import.sh system-password.ldif
```



The "system" user password is reset to "admin"
